**County Administrator Appointment to  
The Canoa Ranch Conservation Committee**

Introduction

At the January 14, 2014 meeting, the Board of Supervisors approved the transition of the Canoa Ranch Community Trust and Oversight Committee (CRCTOC) to the new, 10-member Canoa Ranch Conservation Committee (CRCC). This approval included the appointment of one member to the CRCC by the County Administrator.

I would like to appoint Dr. Wade McLean as my representative on the CRCC. Dr. McLean previously served on the CRCTOC, and his grandfather lived and worked on the ranch when it was owned by Levi Manning.

Dr. McLean would bring a wealth of community experience to the CRCC, including his past service as:

- President of the Arizona State Board of Education
- Former Superintendent of the Marana Unified School District
- Member of the Pima County Bond Advisory Committee
- Current or former Board member for numerous profit organizations

I recommend the Board of Supervisors approve the County Administrator's appointment of Dr. Wade McLean to the Canoa Ranch Conservation Committee for an initial four-year term.
