**Tucson 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Juneteenth Festival

Background

The Tucson 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Juneteenth Festival will take place on June 14, 2014 at the Donna Liggins Recreational Center at 2160 N. Sixth Avenue. The theme of this year's event is "Today's Youth, Tomorrow's Leaders." The goal of the Juneteenth Festival is to provide an opportunity to educate the community regarding health and wellness in the community, a priority of the County.

The Festival will include health resources booths, children's activities, music, demonstrations, outside vendors, guest speakers and other activities. Nutritious foods such as fresh fruits and vegetables, as well as water, will be provided without charge to Festival participants.
