Re: **September 19, 2014 Bond Advisory Committee Meeting**

At their meeting today under Agenda Item 5, the Bond Advisory Committee (BAC), after debate, decided to accept the project preference worksheets for tally. The BAC has stressed that tallying these project preference worksheets was only one measure of determining project priorities and/or rankings and that there would be comprehensive continuing discussions regarding the projects submitted for consideration.

Twenty-one members attended today's BAC meeting, and 19 submitted completed project preference worksheets at the meeting. The worksheets were collected and tallied by staff during the meeting and the results distributed to the BAC members as the meeting concluded.

Attached to this memorandum are copies of the results. One set of results is sorted by the number of "Yes" responses, with the project with the highest number of "Yes" responses appearing at the top. The second set of results is sorted by "No" responses, with projects receiving the highest number of "No" responses at the top.
