
# Driver's Training Facility

## Project Need

**Modern Regional Facility meeting the driver safety requirements of Police ,  
Fire and Non-Public Safety entities in Pima County and Southern Arizona**

- **Current facility needs to be replaced due to age, level of use, and safety**
- **No equivalent facility available in Southern Arizona**
- **Supports tactical and driver skill enhancement of 33 Public Safety Jurisdictions in Pima County**
- **Also provides non-public safety training to agencies to include Suntran, Dept of Motor Vehicles and Teen Driver Safety Programs**





- 337,000 SF asphalt driver-training track
- 112,000 SF irrigated concrete skid pad
- Training room facility and Ramada for 50 people

**Project Budget:**  
**\$3.1 million**


# Driver's Training Facility Benefits

## Enhanced Driver Safety

- Modernized surface for tactical driving practice with the capability to employ public safety and civilian vehicle dynamics
- Leverage current high-speed loop
- Concrete skid pad added to increase overall training area for both high and low speed skid maneuvering
- One quarter of the track will also meet the needs of unique motorcycle training

## Unique surface and academic setting for realistic training

- Ramada for 50 people will enable shaded academic area located within immediate access to training area
- Track elements provide the ability to train in a safe but realistic environment



# Multi-purpose Facility Need

- The academy is in need of additional classroom space
- Indoor area for physical training and testing needed
- Additional locker room facilities
- Large meeting room for 900 people
- Emergency management
  - Reception site
  - Community forum



# Judgmental Firearms Training Facility Project Need

- **Currently, limited capability to employ “live-fire” contemporary training including individual and multi-shooter scenarios**
- **No current capability to train “Live-fire” high powered rifle use for judgemental targets**
- **High powered rifles present unique challenges due to the current lack of a safe, long-range training facility**





- 2,500 SF 300-degree indoor range
  - Provides live-fire “real-life” situations
  - Allows for movement in three dimensions
  - Real-time, video-reinforced instruction and feedback
- 300 meter outdoor range
  - Allows for up to 10 Sworn to safely shoot high-powered rifles at multiple ranges using judgemental targets

# Judgemental Firearms Training Facility - Project Scope

**Project Budget:  
\$4.1 million**



# Judgemental Firearms Training Project Benefit

- **Indoor Range**
  - Allowing live-fire scenario training using conventional pistol ammunition
  - 300 Degree, three dimensional simulation for realistic contemporary training situations
  - Real-time video and instructional feedback
- **Outdoor Judgemental Target Rifle Range**
  - Allows for the movement of up to 10 Officers providing realistic, incremental range target and shoot capability
  - Reinforcement of judgement criteria for analyzing the distance between officers and suspects in a real-world environment
