

Re: Reimbursement Approval for Requested Hazardous Materials Conferences and Training

Mr. Wisner:

This letter supports your request for reimbursement of expenses for enhancement of hazardous materials response capacity within your planning district as outlined in your initial requests. Reimbursement will be from our State's Hazardous Materials Grant Program (HMEP), managed by the Training and Exercise Office of the Arizona Division of Emergency Management (ADEM). As an approved reimbursement, all expenses must be incurred prior to September 30th, 2013, which is the final date of the grant supporting this request.

The ADEM Training and Exercise Office agrees to reimburse the Pima County LEPC for the following events up to the amounts listed on the initial requests:

- Ethanol Training-Renewable Fuels - \$6,500
- Airgas Container Emergencies Program (ACE) - \$500
- HazMat IQ - \$15,000

- Reimbursement is limited to the above approved requests. If your request differs during the grant period, please notify the ADEM Training and Exercise Office immediately.
- Submit your request(s) for reimbursement to the ADEM Training and Exercise Office within 30 days after completion of each event. Request(s) for reimbursement received after this date may be denied. ALL final requests must be submitted no later than November 15th, 2013 or they will be denied.
- Request(s) for reimbursement must include copies of invoices and receipts, attendance rosters, and be organized for easy tracking.
