

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS AND WELFARE; AMENDING PIMA COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 9.70.010 TO PROHIBIT ADULTS AGES EIGHTEEN TO TWENTY-ONE FROM PERMITTING OR ENCOURAGING UNDERAGE DRINKING.

SECTION 1: Section 9.70.010 of the Pima County Code is amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9.70

UNDERAGE DRINKING

9.70.010 – Permitting or encouraging underage drinking.

- A. No person of legal drinking age in Arizona eighteen years of age or older may knowingly permit or fail to take reasonable action to prevent the illegal consumption of spirituous liquor by an underage person on premises owned by the person or under the person's control. This section does not apply to spirituous liquor used exclusively as part of a religious service.
- B. A person who violates this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
- C. Spirituous liquor has the same meaning as in Title 4 of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective 30 days after the date of adoption.
