- 3) **Air Quality Monitoring Presentation**
Wayne Byrd, PDEQ, will discuss the region's air quality and the monitoring system in 2007 versus 2006.
- 4) **Stage II Vapor Recovery**
Ms. Ursula Kramer is providing information on Stage II Vapor Recovery. The Board of Supervisors will discuss this issue in November. Stage II Vapor Recovery is an emissions control technique that captures refueling vapors from a gas station's dispensing nozzles and returns them to the gas station's underground storage tank.
- 5) **Air Quality Fee Rule Proposal**
Richard Grimaldi will talk about PDEQ's air quality proposal to amend Titles 17.04.340, 17.12.190, 17.12.400, 17.12.510 and 17.12.520. This rule amendment will affect fees related to individual and general air quality permits. A stakeholder meeting was held on October 17 and the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors is November 20.
- 6) **Leukemia Cluster Update**
Dr. Mark Witten will report on the latest information regarding the leukemia clusters in Fallon, NV and Sierra Vista, AZ.
- 7) **Community Water/CAP**
Allan MacDonald of EQAC will lead the discussion to summarize the following information:
 - Depth of the groundwater in the Santa Cruz River Basin near Green Valley;
 - Augusta Resources Corp.'s plans for an open pit mine in Rosemont Canyon area;
 - PC Flood Control District's letter outlining negative environmental impacts to Davidson Canyon and Cienega Watershed; and
 - Community Water Co's agreement with Augusta Resources to bring CAP water to Green Valley/Sahuarita area.
- 8) **Solid Waste Report**
Ms. Kramer will report on the latest ordinance amendments going into effect at the Pima County landfills and Transfer Stations.
- 9) **PDEQ Staff Report**
Ms. Kramer will brief the EQAC on events that have occurred since the last EQAC meeting in September, 2007.
