- 3) Ozone Standard – Proposed Revision of EPA Standards
Wayne Byrd, Program Manager for PDEQ, will provide information about the new ozone standards proposed by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the possible impact on Pima County.

- 4) PDEQ Monitoring Program presentation
One of PDEQ's goals is to reduce harmful air pollution to safe and healthy levels and to maintain those levels. In order to meet this goal, air pollution needs to be defined in a geographical area through air monitoring. Wayne Byrd, Program Manager for PDEQ, is going to speak about Pima County's air monitoring network.

- 5) ASARCO update
In 2009 PDEQ conducted inspections at ASARCO in response to complaints from the public and issued an Opportunity to Correct to ASARCO for failure to monitor dust emissions weekly and for allowing dust to cross property boundaries without taking adequate controls. In addition, PDEQ issued two Notice of Violations (NOV) to ASARCO for violations of the opacity standard that occurred in November and December, 2009. Staff will provide updated information on this issue.
