**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA
RELATING TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE AIR QUALITY HEARING BOARD;
AMENDING THE PIMA COUNTY CODE SECTION 17.04.190.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Chapter 17.04, Section 17.04.190 of the Pima County Code is amended to read as follows.

17.04.190 Composition.

A. The hearing board shall consist of five members.

1. The five members . . .

2. One member shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in this state.

B. At least a majority of the hearing board members shall not individually have a substantial interest in an emission source subject to permits or enforcement orders issued pursuant to this title. Substantial interest means any pecuniary or proprietary interest, either direct or indirect, other than a remote interest.

Section 2. This ordinance is effective 31 days after the date of adoption.
