RE: Submittal of Pima County Rules revising the Pima County Portion of the Arizona State Implementation Plan for Section 110(a)(2) Infrastructure

Dear Mr. Blumenfeld:

Consistent with the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 49-104, 49-404, 49-406, and the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 40, §§ 51.102 through 51.104, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) hereby adopts and submits to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Pima County Rules 17.04.190, Composition, adopted September 28, 1993, 17.12.040, Reporting for Compliance Evaluations, adopted September 28, 1993, and 17.24.040, Reporting Requirements, adopted April 19, 2005, as a revision to the Pima County portion of the Arizona State Implementation Plan (SIP). This revision strengthens the existing rules and also replaces Rule 622 with Rule 17.12.040.


Rules 17.04.190, 17.12.040, and 17.24.040 were referenced as part of ADEQ's SIP supplement to the *Clean Air Act Sections 110(a)(1) and (2): Implementation of 2006 PM_{2.5} National Ambient Air Quality Standards, 1997 PM_{2.5} National Ambient Air Quality Standards, and 1997 8-hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards*, which was submitted to the EPA on August 24, 2012. This submission corrects the deficiencies required for Clean Air Act (CAA) Section 110(a)(2)(e)(ii), which specifies hearing boards composition requirements, and 110(a)(2)(F) regarding stationary source monitoring and reporting. These deficiencies were outlined in 77 FR 66398 and 77 FR 66405 (November 5, 2012).
