

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-15**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY,  
ARIZONA, RELATING TO SOLID WASTE; AMENDING THE EXISTING FEE  
SCHEDULE FOR PIMA COUNTY'S SOLID WASTE FACILITIES.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY,  
ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 2 of Pima County Ordinance Number 2013-35 is amended as follows:

**FEE SCHEDULE FOR LANDFILLS AND TRANSFER STATIONS**

**A. COMMERCIAL HAULERS**

The fees for commercial haulers shall be prorated fractionally based on tonnage.




