


# Instructions to Use MapGuide for Stormwater Management

1. Type in your browser's address bar: <http://gis.pima.gov/maps>
2. Select "Pima County MapGuide Maps"
3. Select "Main MapGuide Map". Additional software may need to be installed at this point, depending upon your computer's configuration and browser. When the software is uploaded, the website page will look like this:



4. Navigate to the location you are interested in using one of two methods:
  - Using the **Navigation bar**, select zoom in (+), position cursor in the area of interest, click until you see the property. -OR-
  - Enter the numbers of the street address in the blue outline box (above the Navigation bar). Then click on "Adr Num" and select the street from the dropdown dialog box.
5. In the **GIS Layers**, turn on the following layers by clicking on the following topics:
  - Lines: Washes – All
  - Lines: Topography – All 2 foot Topography – NAVD88 with labels
  - Translucent Polygons: Stormwater Permit Areas - AZPDES
  - Imagery: 2011 PAG Color Orthophoto Imagery (6 inch resolution)
6. This information can be used to determine the following:
  - Red topographic lines: Direction rainwater runoff will take from the highest elevation to the lowest elevation.
  - Blue (or purple) lines: Nearest receiving water
  - Stormwater Permit Area: Identify which Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) your property is located within.
