Under the leadership of LULAC Council #1057, over 100,000 6th through 12th grade students have participated in the Annual LULAC Youth Leadership Conference, which has received national recognition from Past President Bill Clinton, Former First Ladies Hillary Clinton and Barbara Bush, the National Latino Children's Institute, the City of Tucson, Metropolitan Education Commission, the NAACP MLK Drum Major Award, and by the Tucson Hispanic Coalition.

With proceeds raised by the annual Educator's Awards and Scholarship Banquet, which was founded by Richard and Mary Fimbres and David and Kathy Rodriguez, LULAC Council #1057 has been able to sponsor students to attend the Washington National Youth Leadership Seminar and provide scholarships with LULAC's National Scholarship Foundation. In 1997 the Manuel de Jesus Alvarado Scholarship Fund was created to provide local scholarships to needy youth.

LULAC Council #1057 has also been a pioneer in the Hispanic community. Having supported the creation of the Hispanic Student Endowment Fund at Pima County Community College, Council #1057 has also hosted a Young Readers Program, provided bike helmets, child safety seats and booster seats, computers and holiday food boxes to needy families and has helped to host an annual Children's Christmas party in partnership with the Knights of Columbus
