I'll send draft, re: market, this weekend for the general discussion. Cox is back by the end of the month, I think - Judy knows better, I'm sure. In any case, he probably needs to be involved in the food bank/community market conversation.

I'm not sure the county can do anything about the food bank. I haven't done the research yet, but the original Ajo Food Bank was an satellite of the Tucson Community Food Bank, and not an agency of Pima County. I think it - the mothership - got outside-agency funding from the county, but that was stopped four or five years ago. I'm not sure that what exists now in Ajo is even a satellite any longer, but rather a non-profit entity (i.e. church) at which the Community Food Bank in Tucson drops off loads.
