Dear Supervisor Elias:


For the last twenty-three years, the Pueblo Gardens Neighborhood Association has held a Dr. Martin Luther King Breakfast. We hold this event both to honor the memory and spirit of Dr. King and to raise funds to help our neighborhood youth.

We do not charge for the breakfast, but do accept donations and hold a raffle using donated items from businesses, dignitaries, and organizations like the UofA basketball team. If we receive special gifts, like a basketball signed by the team, we hold a silent auction. We have the program featuring a keynote speaker.

The money, after expenses, goes to youth in the neighborhood, who write to us asking for help to pay for classes or events to better themselves. All that we ask in return is that they do something to benefit their neighborhood, like serving at the breakfast, helping with neighborhood cleanups, or attending meetings for us to receive input from them about issues they face. We have helped our fifth and eighth grade classes go on end of the year trips to California, paid fees for youths to go to basketball camp, play football, attend cheerleading camp, attend summer school, bought musical instruments for the elementary school, helped band students to attend a school sponsored event in Disneyland, acknowledged honor roll students with a dinner at Red Lobster, sponsored and awarded prizes for an essay and art contest about Dr. King, etc.

We would like to invite you to join us at our 24<sup>th</sup> Annual breakfast this year. It will be held on Saturday, January 18, 2014 at the Holmes Tuttle Boys' and Girls' Club, 2585 E. 36<sup>th</sup> Street, Tucson AZ..
