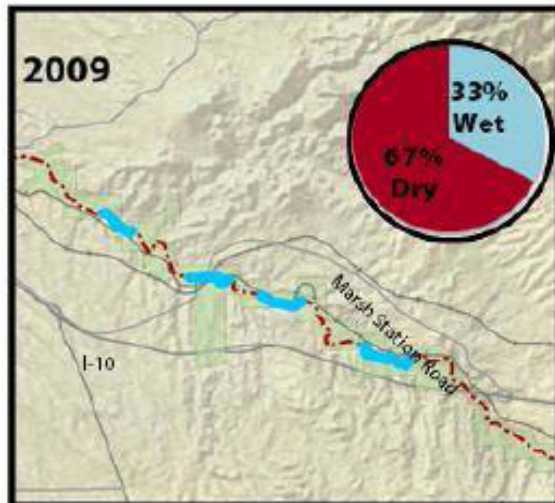


Figure 10. Map of Cienega Creek's June Flowing Reaches with Wet/Dry Pie Charts, 1999 to 2009

## Lower Cienega Creek June Flow Extent 1999 - 2009

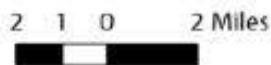


The percentage wet or dry is based on length of the flow within 9.5 miles of the Pima County Natural Preserve, which is measured quarterly. June represents the driest time of year and therefore, the minimal perennial flow in the creek. PAG monitors Cienega Creek in coordination with Pima County.
