

WETLANDS AND WILDLIFE CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS



Pima County Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation is seeking teachers to participate in 2-day curriculum-consultation workshops to develop hands-on, experiential curriculum on wetland ecology, wildlife conservation, and wildlife corridors. Participants work in curriculum teams to review existing resources, identify gaps, and brainstorm directions for new programs. Participating teachers help to create educational resources that align with STEM, Common Core, and Next Generation Science Standards and extend student learning beyond the classroom.

Participants will receive a \$75 stipend and be eligible for 9 hours of professional development credit.
