This Addendum addresses questions raised through 11:30 am on March 16, 2016. This addendum shall be incorporated and made part of the SFQ Documents as though included therein. **This addendum is 1 page.**

CLARIFICATIONS / ANSWERS TO RESPONDENTS:

Q) We are directed to submit a “signed letter of commitment” which is appears to be Exhibit “B” from the sample contract. **I assume we submit signed Exhibit “B”.**

There is an Exhibit “C” in the sample contract which is a consultant rate schedule. We are directed not submit fee information and I can find nowhere that it directs us to submit Exhibit “C”. **I assume we do NOT submit Exhibit “C”.**

A) Both assumptions are correct. Exhibit B should be signed and submitted within the SOQ and Exhibit C should not be submitted.

Q) Is a notice of intent to respond required in addition to the attendance at the pre-submittal meeting? If so, by when?

A) No. A notice of intent to respond is not a requirement for a consultant to submit a Statement of Qualifications.

Q) There is no specific statement in the SFQ relative to control survey for the projects. Please provide confirmation that survey services (horizontal control, topography, culture, r/w) to be required as a part of the contract; or will they be performed/provided by the County?

A) Survey services will be predominately performed by Pima County.

Q) What format (i.e. AutoCAD?) is expected/required for survey control, and design engineering?

A) Pima County Survey uses AutoCad 2016 and Design Engineering uses Micro Station.

All other specifications, terms and conditions, not specifically changed by this Addendum will remain the same.
