SOLICITATION NO. 216637 – DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR INA RD: SHANNON RD TO LA CHOLLA BLVD

QUESTIONS/CLARIFICATIONS/REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION:

Q) Is there a requirement for geo-tech engineering?

A) No, geotech is not required for this project.

Q) Can the Respondent's statement be provided in word, or a document that can be filled out electronically.

A) Yes it will be posted on the website.

Q) For Landscape plant inventory and salvage are you going by ADOT or Pima County Standards/requirements.

A) Pima County requirements and or standards would be used.

Q) The RFQ indicates that the County will provide a survey of the project site. Will this survey be of sufficient detail to make a determination as to whether or not existing features such as curb ramps meet applicable ADA standards?

A) YES – per the IFB SOW the consultant is responsible to work with PC Survey to obtain survey data, and data shall be sufficient to support detailed design activities.

Q) Public Meetings will the consultant be responsible to schedule places and coordinate times for the public meetings.

A) The department of transportation's public relations will send out notices and make location arrangements, it is the consultant's responsibility to attend and provide exhibits as needed.

Q) What is the estimated construction budget?

A) The estimated construction budget is \$900,000.

Q) Areas where the sidewalk width varies, ie length of 4' sidewalk, does the County want bulb outs in some areas?

A) For any segment of existing sidewalk that doesn't meet current standards, the intent is to leave as much in place as possible in order to minimize cost and impact. However, the design team will need to coordinate an evaluation with PCDOT to identify what modifications may be needed in order to comply with ADA requirements. All new sidewalk will be per current PCDOT standards.

All other requirements and terms of the Solicitation remain unchanged. Respondents are required to certify receipt of this addendum in their Statement of Qualifications (SOQ). Failure to do so may result in declaration of the bid as non-responsive.
