IFB 158426: PUMP RENTAL WITH ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES ADDENDUM 3

IFB is due: JAN. 22, 2015 AT OR BEFORE 3:00 P.M. LOCAL ARIZONA TIME (MST)

The following clarifications shall be incorporated into **IFB #158426**:

1. Change on page 6: **4. PRODUCT OR SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE**: as follows:

From: "...Pima County is not responsible for theft or damage to vendor's property..."

To: "...RWRD will be responsible for theft or damage when equipment is under Pima County control..."

2. Change on page 7: **4. PRODUCT OR SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE**: as follows:

From: "...Vendor will perform repairs at no additional cost to Pima County..."

To: "...Vendor will perform repairs at no additional cost to Pima County if needed repair is due to improper installation or damage caused by vendor. If needed repair is due to damage caused by Pima County the cost of repair will be negotiated and paid by Pima County..."

3. Change on page 7: **4. PRODUCT OR SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE**: as follows:

From: "...Vendor must provide all their own equipment and/or tools to perform the necessary inspections/repairs at no additional cost to Pima County..."

To: "...Vendor must provide all their own equipment and/or tools to perform the necessary inspections/repairs at no additional cost to Pima County. **The cost of "non" standard or vendor "rented" equipment to install pump/piping systems will be paid for at invoice cost. All vendor owned equipment used to install equipment needs to be in the unit price...**"

4. Change on page 7: **4. PRODUCT OR SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE**: as follows:

From: "...pricing must be FOB Destination and Freight Prepaid Not Billed..."

To: "...FOB Destination and Freight Prepaid Not Billed **for local available items. Freight on equipment transferred at Pima County request will be paid for at invoice cost...**"

5. Change on page 7: **4. PRODUCT OR SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE**: as follows:

From: "...Vendor must be able to deliver requested equipment within 4 hours..."

To: "...Vendor must be able to deliver requested equipment within **24 hours. Vendor shall notify Pima County immediately if the requested equipment is a special order or non-stocked equipment and not available within 24 hours. Delivery issues will be negotiated and/or resolved with the department...**"

6. CLARIFICATION as follows:

QUESTION: The solicitation does not address the operation of any temporary rental system installed for Pima County. Who will be operating, monitoring, fueling, providing maintenance, etc. to the system while in operation? If

it is the responsibility of the bidder to provide these services, there are not bid items covering the costs of such services.

ANSWER: Pima County will operate and fuel the equipment while in operation. The actual maintenance schedule and operating instructions shall be established prior to the equipment being installed. This will include but not be limited to number of operating hours between lubrications. If equipment is close to annual maintenance requirements vendor shall perform that work prior to installation of equipment on Pima County property.

7. **CLARIFICATION** as follows:

QUESTION: The solicitation has references to emergency response conditions (i.e. 4 hour response time, weekend hours, over-time hours, etc.). If it is the intent of the county to have an emergency response contract, we need to have language in the contract and solicitation addressing these conditions including cost line items for billing.

ANSWER: Pima County will work with the vendor if an emergency situation requires equipment to be delivered in less than 24 hours. Pima County will not pay for equipment to be reserved or held until needed in anticipation of an emergency.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.

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
