SOLICITATION NO. 232437 RENTAL OF EMERGENCY GENERATORS 5 MW OR GREATER AND ACCESSORIES

Be advised of the following changes, clarifications and/or additions to the above-referenced Solicitation as stated in the following Addendum.

CHANGES AND/OR ADDITIONS:

CHANGE: Replace Offer Agreement Item #4, Product or Service Specifications & Scope, Contractor Responsibilities and Pima County Responsibilities, in their entirety, With the Following:

Contractor Responsibilities:

- Contractor guarantees delivery of a Generator 5 MW or greater in less than 18 hours from the time of issuance of Delivery Order (DO) or Delivery Order Maximo (DOM).
- Generator must be in good working condition and up to date on all required maintenance and needed services.
- Generator to have minimum output of 13,800 volts AC, 225 Amps, 3 phase wye configuration.
- Generator to be trailer mounted, diesel powered, reciprocating engine or turbine, with a minimum 1000 gallon diesel storage tank on board. Vendor to provide fuel consumption rates at full load.
- Bid based on triple shift operations,
- Contractor is to service the equipment on Plant Site and to provide complete billing rates and timing. Vendor is also required to give 48 hour notice on equipment maintenance needs so plant can plan for these events.
- Contractor to provide Port to Port freight in bid, for billing purposes
- Contractor to be able to provide 24/7 services to deliver and repair equipment.
- Contractor must provide a 24/7 order phone number
- Contractor is responsible to secure and level generator once delivered
- Contractor will be responsible to provide a technician on plant site as long as the generator is running.
- Contractor will be responsible to provide an electrician for all physical connections to generator, including conduit, walkway or any other needed devices to hook up the generator.
- Contractor will be responsible for daily fluid checks and coolant level checks.
- Contractor will deliver generator fully fueled
- Contractor shall provide relay and breaker protection as deemed necessary by contractor to protect the supplied equipment.

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Pima County Responsibilities:

- RWRD will be responsible for providing ground rods for equipment grounding
- RWRD will be responsible for providing fuel used on plant site and return to vendor full.
- RWRD will be responsible for inspecting installation and assist in coordination
- RWRD will provide a S&C style medium voltage switching cabinet for connection with Contractor supplied equipment:
 - RWRD switching cabinet will be provided with circuit overcurrent protection for RWRD equipment and conductors only.
 - Switching cabinet will be provided with phase surge protection.
 - Switching cabinet will be equipped with load break terminals for connection with the standby generator phase conductors. Switching cabinet terminals shall be considered a point of common coupling between RWRD equipment and the contractor supplied equipment.
 - Switching cabinet to be located adjacent to the equipment mobilization and setup area, as indicated during the pre-bid walk.
 - RWRD will be responsible for operation of switching cabinet.
- RWRD will provide a single high resistance ground unit:
 - High resistance ground will serve to protect RWRD equipment from a single phase to ground fault.
 - High resistance neutral terminal will be considered a point of common coupling between RWRD equipment and contractor supplied equipment.
 - High resistance ground to be located adjacent to the equipment mobilization and setup area, as indicated during the pre-bid walk.
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- RWRD will provided Time Current Curves (TCC's) for relevant county owned protective devices.
- RWRD will provide all operation of county owned equipment including, opening and closing of breakers and switches.
