## Make April *Earth Month*

Officially *Earth Day* is April 22 but one day is simply not enough time to practice sustainability. Make April *Earth Month* by challenging yourself to practice 30 days of the 3Rs — Reduce, ReUse, Recycle:

### Reduce

- Buy only what you will use
- Buy in bulk to reduce packaging
- Look for packaging that can be recycled

### ReUse

- Donate clothing and textiles you no longer use
- Repurpose packaging to help you organize and store things

### Recycle

- 40% of what you throw away can be recycled—recycle right
- Use the My Waste app to look for recycling options in Tucson

Finally, mark your calendar to attend an Earth Day celebration, April 22, 2017, 10 am – 2 pm at the Tucson Children’s Museum. It’s a free, family-friendly event to learn more about caring for our planet and being stewards of our environment.

## New County-wide Resident Alert System

During an emergency, urgent messaging is effective only if it reaches you quickly. That’s what Pima County’s new mass notification system can do.

### How It Works

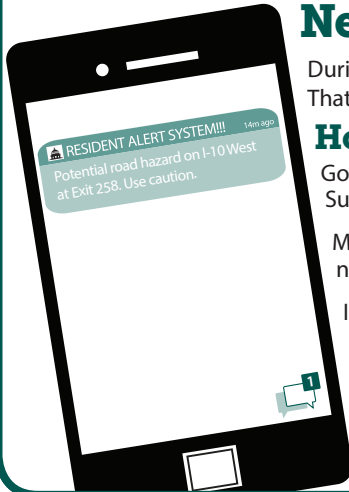
Go to [myalerts.pima.gov](http://myalerts.pima.gov) to create a profile and start receiving notifications. Subscribers can specify how they want to be notified\*.

Messages could warn of potential safety hazards, sewer-related issues, or any number of emergency situations.
