Neighborhood Recycling Center Changes July 1

Neighborhood Recycling Centers (NRC) offer a free and convenient way to drop off any recyclables that would go in a Blue Barrel. City of Tucson Environmental Services will be making changes to many NRC locations for easier maintenance and monitoring. Beginning July 1, 2017, NRCs can be found at these locations:

- Mansfield Park, on 4th Ave., one block south of Grant Rd.
- Ward 5 Council Office, 4300 S. Park Ave.
- Patrick K. Hardesty Center, northwest corner of Alvernon Way and 22nd St.



- Los Reales Landfill, 5300 E. Los Reales Rd.
- Fire Station 15, 2002 S. Mission Rd.
- Eastside City Hall, 7575 E. Speedway Blvd.
- Ward 4 Office, 8123 E. Poinciana Dr.

Rate Increase Takes Effect June 1, 2017



On April 18, 2017, the Pima County Board of Supervisors approved a three percent increase to sewer user fees in order to meet the rising costs of maintaining treatment plants in compliance with state and federal regulations, monitoring and mitigating odors, and providing reliable customer service. The increase will take effect **June 1, 2017**, and will raise the average monthly residential sewer bill by **\$1.12** a month.
