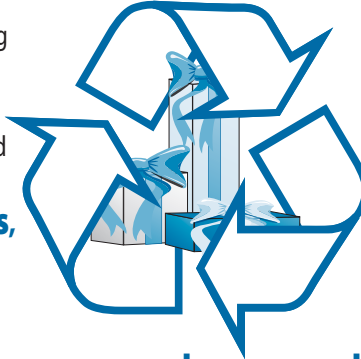


CITY OF TUCSON ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES

- 5) **Make gift wrap** useful and re-useable: put cookies in a clean, empty flower pot or put jewelry in a new pair of gloves or socks.

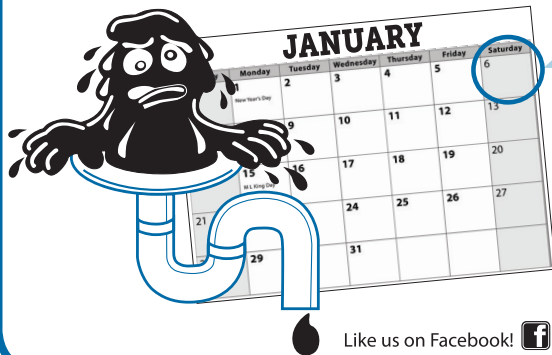
If you **recycle-reuse-reduce** right, there will be plenty of space in your trash container for things that belong in the landfill.
