

Effective June 1, 2017, The Board of Supervisors revised the Sewer Connection fee rate structure.

Since June 1, 2012, Sewer Connection fees are calculated based on water meter size and not fixture unit equivalents.

Residential water meters have one rate of \$4,188. Churches and Schools will no longer be considered residential and will be charged the commercial or industrial rate.

<b>Residential Water Meters</b>	
<b>Water Meter Size</b>	<b>Amount</b>
<b>5/8 or 3/4 and 1"</b>	<b>\$4,188</b>

Residential remodels constructing a detached structure that install an additional water meter will pay a Sewer Connection fee based on the new water meter.

Residential remodels that change the use of the property to Commercial or Industrial will be evaluated for additional Sewer Connection fees.

Commercial or Industrial Tenant Improvements (TI's) will be evaluated for additional Sewer Connection fees.

Commercial, Industrial, and Multi-Family projects will pay the following fees based on water meter size(s):

<b>5/8 or 3/4"</b>	<b>\$4,188</b>
<b>1"</b>	<b>\$8,734</b>
<b>1 1/2"</b>	<b>\$27,841</b>
<b>2"</b>	<b>\$71,884</b>
<b>3"</b>	<b>\$167,385</b>
<b>4"</b>	<b>\$374,601</b>

Water meter sizes above 4": the fee will be determined on a case by case basis.
