| 4. | The applicant shall hold the Wastewater Management Department, and its officers and employees, harmless for any liability associated with the access of and/or physical entry into the public sanitary sewer by the applicant’s employees. |
| 5. | The Sanitary Sewer Access Permit shall neither constitute nor replace the Confined Space Entry Permit that the applicant must issue, in accordance with the applicant’s written confined space entry procedures as required for OSHA compliance, at the site of and at the time of the physical confined space entry. |
