

Public Notice of Proposed Code Amendments for Mt. Lemmon Sewer Connections and User Fee Surcharges

Pursuant to ARS §11-251.13, Pima County is providing notice that this item will be heard on **Tuesday, February 5, 2019** and moved from the Tuesday, January 8, 2019 Pima County Board of Supervisors meeting as originally scheduled. The Pima County Board of Supervisors will consider proposed changes to sunset the connection Standby Status for the Mt. Lemmon service area within five years, include an Operations Surcharge (currently set at zero), adjust conservation measures to align with current plumbing standards, and streamline code narrative.

There will be an opportunity for the public to speak to the proposed changes during the public hearing at the Pima County Board of Supervisors' meeting.

The proposed code amendments to the Pima County Code 13.28 – Mt. Lemmon Sewer Connections and 13.32 – Mt. Lemmon User Fee Surcharges can be viewed at the Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department, 201 N Stone Avenue, 8th Floor, Tucson, AZ 85701.
