JOB TITLE: Sample Prep Technician

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Sample Prep Technician at Skyline Assayers & Laboratories performs a variety of tasks necessary to prepare mining samples for testing in the Laboratory Department. The process begins with checking bags of ore samples and verifying they match paperwork provided by the customer. Once this all checks out, Sample Prep Techs dry, crush, and pulverize the samples using various ovens and machines. The resulting powdery material is carefully logged and packaged for testing in the laboratory. Attention to detail is critical in record keeping and sample preparation to avoid costly, time-consuming errors. Hard work, heavy lifting and repetitive tasks are a consistent part of the Sample Prep Technician's workday. The entire work day takes place while standing.

After a probationary period of 60 days, Skyline offers full-time employees Health insurance for \$30.00 per pay period. After the same probationary period, Dental, Vision, Life, and Short- and Long-Term Disability Insurance are 100% employer paid for full-time employees

Full-time Skyline employees receive 9 paid holidays

Paid Time Off (PTO) begins accruing on the first day of employment

Skyline offers a 401(k), with an employer match after 90 days of employment

Employees that work on the 2nd or 3rd shift receive a differential of \$0.65 per hour

SALARY: \$17.00 per hour

APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must consent to pre-employment urine drug screen and 90-day "lookback" hair drug screen, as well as random and for-cause (post-incident) drug screening
- Must consent to criminal background check, including fingerprints
- Must pass E-Verify screening
- Must be willing to be fitted for a respirator (breathing mask) undergo a hearing test before employment
- Must be willing to work in dusty conditions while wearing a respirator, safety glasses and hearing protection. Steel-toed boots are required at all times. Skyline allows \$100 year boot reimbursement
- Must come to work for every scheduled shift, including 5 hours of overtime every other Saturday
- Must be detail-oriented, able to read numbers, do simple calculations with a calculator, and visually distinguish between different colors of mining samples
- Must be able to lift up to 65 pounds
