**NEIGHBORHOOD REINVESTMENT PROPOSALS (Presentation)**

Ms. Nixon informed the Committee that the Barrio Santa Rosa proposal was for \$79,431

and the Country Glenn Neighborhood proposal has been reduced to \$191,300. These are the last two proposals to be heard.

- **Barrio Santa Rosa (City of Tucson)**

Mr. Pedro M. Gonzales representing the Barrio Santa Rosa neighborhood presented a proposal requesting \$79,431 for the installation of park shade structures.

- **Country Glenn Neighborhood (City of Tucson)**

Ms. Jennifer Allen and Mr. John Anderson, representing the Country Glenn Neighborhood, presented a proposal requesting \$191,300 for installation of sidewalks, street lighting, chicanes and landscaping.

### **NEIGHBORHOOD REINVESTMENT PROPOSALS (Discussion, Recommendations)**

Ms. Nixon recommended that the Committee discuss each project in the order they were presented to make a tentative recommendation for each before making a final motion regarding recommendations to the Board of Supervisors. Discussion followed.

Ms. Knox moved that the Committee recommend the following Neighborhood Reinvestment projects in the stated amounts:

- a. No previous NR funding
  - i. Santa Cruz Southwest - **\$292,788**
  - ii. Naylor Neighborhood - **\$229,000**
  - iii. Barrio Santa Rosa - **\$87,431**
  - iv. Country Glenn Neighborhood - **\$191,300**
  
- b. Previous NR funding
  - i. South Tucson Community - **\$200,000**
  - ii. Sunset Villa Neighborhood - **\$171,500**
  - iii. Elvira Neighborhood - **\$90,000**
  - iv. Menlo Park Neighborhood - **\$54,599**
  - v. Midvale Park Neighborhood - **\$124,775**
  - vi. Sunnyside Neighborhood - **\$113,500**

Ms. Lopez seconded. **Motion passed unanimously.**

Mr. Bernal moved to reconsider the recommendation to the Board of Supervisors as follows:

Sunset Villa Neighborhood - **\$159,250**  
Midvale Park Neighborhood - **\$137,025**

Ms. Lopez seconded. **Motion passed unanimously**
