What are HUD approved housing counseling agencies?

HUD approved housing counseling agencies are nonprofits that have been certified by HUD to provide a variety of housing services. HUD certification is awarded to nonprofits with proven experience, capacity and ability to work with other community resources. Pima County and the City of Tucson support the nonprofit housing counseling agencies with HUD funds.

What do they do?

Housing counseling agencies provide one-on-one meetings and formal classes on homebuyer education, financial literacy and related housing issues. Counselors keep informed about market trends and new opportunities for home buyers. The types of services provided by these agencies may include:

- Homebuyer education and counseling
- Money management, budgeting and debt counseling
- Mortgage default/foreclosure avoidance
- Serve as liaison on behalf of client with housing industry professionals
- Provide down payment assistance, monetary and emergency assistance and subsidies to qualified clients
- Reverse mortgages counseling
- Review loan documents
- Provide rental housing resources



Housing counselors provide bilingual (English and Spanish) services and will provide services in other languages including ASL as needed.

Many of the housing counseling agencies offer other services not required for HUD certification. Contact each agency for further information.
