TOUMEY PARK MULTI-USE PATH DEDICATION OCTOBER 4, 2014

Ward 6 Council Member Steve Kozachik, Pima County District 2 Supervisor Ramón Valadez, and the City of Tucson Parks and Recreation invite you to join us as we celebrate the opening of the multi-use path at Toumey Park. We would like to thank the Tucson Department of Transportation (TDOT) which coordinated the planning effort with the community. There was two years of community involvement and planning to identify the needs of the neighborhood. With this information, TDOT engineers and staff prepared the construction documents in-house, saving a significant amount of money since a design consultant was not needed. TDOT also provided construction management and inspection services to ensure the project was built to City and County standards. Constant communication with home owners was critical to ensure a seamless transition between private property and public improvements.

This project provides an eight foot wide paved walking path with ADA access and drinking fountains to help improve walkability of the neighborhood and provide opportunities for fitness to the community. Additionally, several traffic mitigation elements were installed to slow down traffic through the Toumey Park Neighborhood. The path has been coated with a heat reducing epoxy paint to minimize the heat stored and radiated back from black asphalt. Lights and electrical outlets have been installed under the ramada. Several new picnic tables have been installed and areas have been created to provide more visual appeal and decrease water use. An ADA accessible paved walk has been constructed to provide clean access to the existing playground which has also been enlarged to accommodate a new swing set. Funding for this project has been provided by Pima County Neighborhood Reinvestment Funds in the amount of \$488,000.
