



**PUBLIC NOTICE:** Each year, Pima County is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to update its Five Year 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan and develop an Annual Action Plan for each fiscal year. The Annual Action Plan outlines the needs, priorities and strategies for housing, supportive services, and community development programs for Pima County. The Plan also establishes policies and goals for the County, and serves as the local government’s application for HUD annual entitlement funding. The projected funding levels contained in the FY 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan will be forwarded to the Pima County Board of Supervisors for a final public hearing, after a 30-day comment period, May 7, 2019.

Pima County estimates \$2,903,833 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. All CDBG projects must meet the HUD National Objective to assist low- and moderate-income persons. Other HUD annual entitlement/formula grant programs detailed in Annual Action Plan for FY 2019-2020 also include estimations for Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) at \$233,372, and City of Tucson/Pima County Consortium HOME Investment Partnership Program funds (HOME) at a total of \$3,508,146 (City of Tucson \$2,487,977 and Pima County \$779,400). Actual funding levels are subject to change and may include additional recaptured “carry-over” funds available from previous program years.

In collaboration with the City of Tucson, Pima County CDNC will hold a meeting open to the public regarding respective FY2019-20 Annual Action Plans as follows:
