From the Seattle City Council


Employers with gross incomes of \$20 million or more per year will pay 14 cents an hour paid for each employee working in Seattle.

Expected to generate \$47 million per year for

- shelter bed capacity, tents, and tiny house encampments
- public health services
- substance abuse services
- criminal justice diversion program
- \$2.5 million in wage increases for homeless program workers, a measure aimed to stabilize this workforce.



Tariffs

It is estimated that President Bush's Steel Tariffs cost about 200,000 American jobs in other industries.

Unemployment Insurance Effective Aug. 3

After someone has been collecting benefits for four weeks they would have to accept a job offer where the employer is offering to pay at least 20 percent more than they are collecting in benefits.

Arizona law limits benefits to \$240 a week and that means someone would have to take any work that pays at least \$288 a week.

The new law requires DES to set up a return-to-work program where those collecting unemployment insurance could become an apprentice or intern at certain companies for up to six weeks while they continue to collect their weekly checks.

No Update

Az is requesting a waiver to impose additional requirements for AHCCCS recipients.

Those ages 19 and 55 would have to work at least 20 hours a week. Work could include GED prep, college classes, and community service for those leaving prison.

Note that there are exceptions and many people on AHCCCS already work.
