I. SOLICITATION

Pima County CSET is seeking one or
more qualified vendor(s) to complete
an analysis of education and training
options in Pima County to support its
Career Pathways Framework for work-
force development. CSET has identified
up to \$20,000 that may be available for
initial development, and up to \$5,000
per year for subsequent annual updates,
depending on funding allocations.

In accordance with Pima County Board
of Supervisors Policy ("Selection and
Contracting of Professional Services"),
Pima County CSET is requesting propo-
sals from Respondents who are quali-
fied, responsible, and willing to provide
services in compliance with all specifica-
tions and requirements contained in
the RFP. Addendums to this RFP may
be issued at any time subsequent to
the publishing of a solicitation. County
reserves the right to extend contracts for
up to four (4) one-year periods.

Proposals must be submitted in ac-
cordance with the RFP. Failure to do
so may be cause for the proposal to be
rejected as non-responsive. Any indi-

debarred or suspended from receiving
federal funds may apply.

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
