Re: **Current Vote Center Locations**

On May 3, 2022, the Board of Supervisors approved 129 Vote Center locations, which were proposed due to their proximity to large residential areas heavy traffic areas, and major employers. Other Vote Center location criteria used are Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility, electrical capacity for equipment, adequate parking, and ease of access and proximity to public transportation. Preference is also given to sites with at least 2,000 square feet of indoor space.

In an update Memorandum to the Board on May 6, 2022, I informed the Board that the Elections Department had been required to make one change to a Vote Center after being notified by the location that the will no longer be able to serve as a voting site. Vote Center 83 – 11300 E Greaterville, two miles west of Highway 83, is under new ownership and undergoing remodeling. A replacement location at 18585 S. Sonoita Highway was identified.

In the intervening months, six (6) additional sites initially proposed as Vote Centers had to be changed. The reason the change was necessitated, the original and the final location are provided below.
