Re: **Pima County HURF Bond Program End of Fiscal Year Update**

Pursuant to the County's Truth in Bonding Code, I will continue to provide twice a year reports to the Board of Supervisors until all Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF) transportation bond projects are complete. Since the only remaining bond projects are transportation projects, these updates are also provided to the Transportation Advisory Committee. The status of the remaining three 1997 HURF bond projects is included below. The first is a City-managed project for which all County contributed bond funds have been spent. While the City's 22<sup>nd</sup> Street project will continue beyond this fiscal year, the County's contribution of bond funding will be exhausted this fiscal year. The County-managed Kolb Road project is under construction with completion scheduled early in this fiscal year.

### 1997 HURF/Transportation Bond Program

#### Completed during the Second Half of FY 2021/22 – City Managed Project

DOT-29, Houghton Road - Golf Links Road to Interstate 10: Remaining County bond funds were contributed to the Valencia Road to Mary Ann Cleveland Way phase of this City of Tucson managed project.

#### Remaining City of Tucson Managed Project

DOT-58, 22nd Street - Interstate 10 to Tucson Boulevard: This project has multiple phases. County bond funds will be applied to the construction phase of Kino Parkway to Tucson Boulevard. Construction begins in late 2022 and bond funds will be exhausted in FY 2022/23.

#### Remaining Pima County Managed Project

DOT-32, Kolb Road - Sabino Road to Sunrise Drive: Under construction with completion in the first half of FY 2022/23.
