Pima County's Strategic Planning Taskforce for digital access, inclusion, and adoption is now – Connect Pima. The rebranding aligns Pima County efforts to create a digital infrastructure and inclusion plan with those of the State of Arizona. Attached is the Connect Pima report for the fourth quarter of 2022.
