Re: **Election Bill Update from Racy and Associates**

As reported previously, more than 135 election related bills were introduced this last session of the Arizona State Legislature. Of those, 13 made it into law. The data below provides a summary of the action taken on 21 bills considered during the year.

#### **Signed into law**

- 1008 elections; recount margin
- 1013 secretary of state; federal form - after reconsideration
- 1260 registration; early voting move notice - after reconsideration
- 1329 elections; counties; tabulation posting
- 1362 early ballot on-site tabulation - after reconsideration
- 1411 early ballots tracking systems
- 1460 election law amendments
- 1477 voter registration; felonies; clerk; database
- 1638 early ballots; visually impaired voters
- 2236 voter registration; request required
- 2237 same day voter registration; prohibition
- 2703 secure online signature collection
- 2839 candidate nominations; signatures; redistricting. with emergency partial court review

- SCR1012 voter identification; affidavit; procedure
- HCR2015 initiatives; supermajority; requirement

#### **Vetoed**

- 2617 Voter Registration; cancellation; causes

#### **Killed**

- 2238 Drop boxes

- 2602 polling places; emergency vote centers
