Re: **Ordinance and Resolution Relating to the Enactment of a General Sales Tax to Fund Street and Highway Repairs throughout Pima County**

Due to advertising requirements and discussion of the Board of Supervisors at the April 17, 2018 on this subject, I will prepare both a new ordinance and resolution.

The May 1, 2018 the Board Meeting cannot be used to consider adoption of the ordinance because of minimum advertising periods. The ordinance will now be advertised based on the present draft and Board discussion to allow the Board to consider adoption of the ordinance at the May 15, 2018 Board Meeting. Ordinance adoption will precede resolution consideration on the agenda at the same meeting.

These actions will allow the Board to fully consider and adopt a Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2018/19 at the May 22, 2018 Board Meeting.

Should the Board adopt the General Sales Tax at the May 15 meeting, staff will adjust the appropriate budget schedules, including revenue sources, property tax rates and budget ceilings for proper inclusion for Tentative Budget adoption on May 22.
