Re: **January 8th Memorial Update**

On the last few Board of Supervisors Agendas, sizable donation agreements have been approved by the Board for the January 8th Memorial. These donations represent the last planned donations and bring the total donated funds to approximately \$2.3 million.

As stated previously, there is no public funding of the Memorial; hence, the Memorial is now being scaled to reflect available funds. Attached is a schematic that is representative of the Memorial scaled to fit available funding.

Final design and construction of the Memorial is scheduled to coincide with the opening of the UA Mineral Museum, no later January 2020.





50% DESIGN DEVELOPMENT UPDATE





THE REVISED MEMORIAL SIZE




MEMORIAL FOOTPRINT - REVISED DESIGN
