Re: Retirement of Community Development and Neighborhood Conservation Director and Appointment of Interim Director

Community Development and Neighborhood Conservation (CDNC) Director Margaret Kish has informed me of her plans to retire as of March 1, 2019. Ms. Kish joined CDNC as director in 2004, when County Administration split the former Community Development Department in two with Community Services Employment and Training (CSET). Prior to that she spent 20 years at the non-profit Catholic Community Services' Pio Decimo Center. In 2018, Ms. Kish's work was recognized by the National Association for County Community and Economic Development when she was named the recipient of the Roy Hoover award, which recognizes individuals who show a commitment to improving the quality of life for the economically disadvantaged.

I have appointed Mr. Daniel Tylutki to serve as the Interim Director upon the retirement of Ms. Kish. Mr. Tylutki has been with Pima County since 2005 and currently serves as the Senior Program Manager in CDNC.

We will miss Margaret, but we wish her the very best.
