Re: **Kino South Expansion Facility Requests**

There has been no extensive marketing and/or advertising campaigns as we continue construction of the Kino South Sports Complex expansion. However, the Pima County Attractions and Tourism Department as well as Visit Tucson are actively engaged in soliciting events for the facility. It is anticipated there will be a featured article in the Sports Destinations magazine regarding the Kino Sports Complex (KSC) as well as the new expansion.

Even without the project being completed, we have received many requests and tentatively scheduled a number of major events for the expanded facilities. These include the following events:

November 5-10, 2020	Big Sky Conference Championships	6-8 fields

November 22-24, 2020	ECNL Regional Youth Tournament	All 12 fields

Additional inquiries have also come from the Junior College Athletic Association National Championships, USA Rugby as well as others.

Many of the larger events, such as the Ft. Lowell Shootout, are required to use the baseball outfields as well as all of the rectangular fields. In 2019 alone there were 12 to 15 events turned away due to the lack of space and available dates. With the additional 12 fields

located at the expanded facility, the baseball fields can now also be used concurrently with soccer, rugby and other events at the facility.

With the addition of the fields available in the expanded facility, the KSC will also be able to expand ongoing field use for local leagues and practices, including the following users:
