Re: **Operation Stonegarden Equipment Grant**

I recently received a request to place an Operation Stonegarden (OPSG) Equipment Grant on the Board of Supervisors meeting agenda. I returned it to the Sheriff since it does not reflect the actual amount that was approved by the Board for the FFY 2018 OPSG Equipment Grant, as it was approved less License Plate Readers (LPR), moving the amount from \$595,600 to \$562,000.

The Sheriff has provided a January 2, 2020 memorandum explaining why the grant was resubmitted as it was, explaining that if there is a change it has to go back through the state and federal process for modification, which would significantly delay the grant approval. The Sheriff is requesting that the original grant amount of \$595,600 be approved, and has indicated he will not purchase the LPRs as was originally agreed to by the Board.

If any item that is placed on the Board of Supervisors future agenda regarding OPSG, this should also be placed on the agenda as well.

Subject: Operation Stonegarden grant

This memo is in response to your letter, dated December 31, 2019, regarding the FFY 2018 Operation Stonegarden grant.

The amount submitted for the equipment grant is \$595,600, which includes a FLIR camera, aviation fuel and license plate readers (LPRs). Although the Board originally denied the purchase of the LPRs, this amendment was never approved by the Arizona Department of Homeland Security due to subsequent requests to amend the grant to allow for humanitarian aid. In order to remove these items and de-obligate this funding, an amendment must be approved by AZDOHS, which will significantly delay this process further. I am requesting approval of the original \$595,600. We will simply not purchase the LPRs, as we originally agreed. This will ensure no further delay in securing the other equipment. The LPR funding not spent will return to AZDOHS for reallocation.

Both grants are proceeding as originally requested and should be considered together. AZDOHS will not permit reimbursement for equipment purchases without a concomitant expenditure of overtime and mileage, i.e. the operational component of the Stonegarden grant.
