Re: **Consent Calendar Item 11 - Housing First Program Contract of the Board's June 23, 2020 Agenda**

Supervisor Miller voted no on the contract with Old Pueblo Community Services as stated below:

"This is general fund money again taxpayer money coming out of the general fund; and one of the things that disturbed me on this contract was that the County Administrator's memorandum indicated that it was possible that 95 percent of the individuals living in the household could be undocumented; and I don't think we should be using taxpayer monies to fund, housing that could be used for this purpose. So, again, I am going to vote NO on this. Thank you."

We have reviewed all of our correspondence as well as our contracts on this matter and the statement is false. Perhaps, the individuals served are homeless, but they are all US citizens. This can be verified through City of Tucson Housing and Community Development staff as they provide housing vouchers and our contractor, Old Pueblo Community Services.
