Re: **Distribution of Personal Protective Equipment During the COVID-19 Pandemic**

Recently, Maricopa County indicated they distributed over 4 million items of personal protective equipment (PPE) since inception of the pandemic.

In reviewing the data from Pima County's Health logistics unit, we have now distributed over 6.7 million items of PPE in the amounts shown below.

Surgical Masks	1,496,200
N95 Masks	375,267
Face Shields	128,078
Gowns	433,888
Nitrile Gloves	4,244,597
Grand Total:	6,739,466
