Re: **Preschools Participating in the Pima Early Education Program for Fiscal Year 2021/22**

## Background

On May 4, 2021, the Board approved the recommended Year 1 plan for the Pima Early Education Program (PEEP) and directed staff to plan for a multi-year program. On May 18 and June 22, the Board approved agreements with First Things First (FTF) to fund additional scholarships to preschools in their Quality First system, agreements with seven school districts to offer new free high quality preschool classes, and a contract with Child-Parent Centers to offer extended day Head Start preschool programming at several locations. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide a list and map of the preschools participating in PEEP this Fiscal Year, as well as an update on program implementation. Keep in mind that these contractors are required to provide monthly performance reports that will then be rolled up into quarterly reports for the Board and other stakeholders. The quarterly reports will be organized according to the overall program goals and guiding principles, and will include metrics for not only PEEP, but also for the preschool subsidy system as a whole. The Board can expect the first quarterly report in October.

## Participating Preschools

Attached is a map and list of preschools that are participating in PEEP. Following the list are definitions for each of the columns. The school district and Head Start locations were known at the time the agreements were approved. However, it was unknown how many of the additional Quality First-like scholarships would be allocated to which preschools until FTF completed their annual allocation process in June. This information is now known and shown on the spreadsheet based on this first allocation. FTF does periodically reallocate unused scholarships, which may change the numbers per preschool throughout the year, and may also add preschools that didn't initially receive PEEP scholarships. The FTF allocation process is explained in more detail below.

We know from decades of research that children from low income families, children of color and dual language learners, benefit greatly from these high quality preschool experiences. While our eligibility for PEEPs is restricted to children from low income families, participating school districts will be reporting the number of children enrolled by race, ethnicity and any dual language learners. While FTF does not collect such data, we will soon be able to overlay new 2020 census data, as well as a wealth of other GIS layers in our library to determine whether participating school districts are located in areas of highest need. There will be

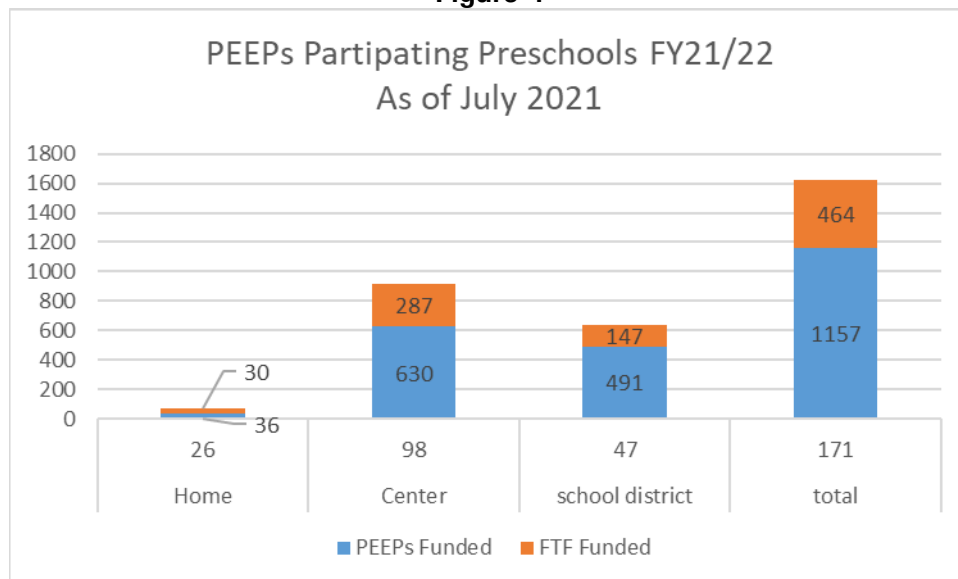
opportunities in the future, especially in working with school districts, to support targeted expansion where most needed.

As the Board directed, participating preschools include the full mixed of preschool types, including home-based programs, centers and school district preschools. Below is a table showing the 171 participating preschools by type, offering a total of 1,157 PEEP scholarships, free preschool slots or extended day Head Start to low income preschool age children. Some of these preschools were also allocated FTF funded QF scholarships totaling 464; however, these are available for children ages birth thru 5. The monthly reports from FTF will include the number of FTF funded scholarships used by age so that we can track how many are being used by preschool age children.

First Things First Additional Quality First Scholarships funded by Pima County

The following is an update on the allocation process for these scholarships:

- FTF was able to allocate more PEEPs (Pima funded) scholarships than initially estimated (599 vs 560) across their Quality First (QF) network of preschools
- FTF followed their traditional QF scholarship allocation formula per our IGA, which favors larger higher rated preschools. The formula also considered the historical usage of scholarships since FY2016 to determine the maximum a preschool may be able to use. This resulted in 44 preschools not receiving an allocation of Pima County funded scholarships as the number of FTF funded scholarships allocated met the estimated maximum. These 44 preschools are not included in the attached map and list since they did not receive Pima funded scholarships.
- In prior years, FTF did not allocate scholarships to preschools in certain zip codes in the Pima South region that generally had higher median incomes, and did not allocate scholarships to 2-star providers. For this year, per our IGA, Pima County funded scholarships were allocated to QF preschools regardless of zip code and to 2-star providers to assist with enrollment recovery from the pandemic. This means that some QF preschools received scholarships for the first time (including Vail preschools and 2-star preschools).
- Pima County funded scholarships are the same as FTF funded traditional QF scholarships but are limited to 3-5 year olds, and traditional QF scholarships must be used first since Pima County's program is a last-dollar-in program (meaning maximize other funding for scholarships before Pima County funding).
- Like FTF funded traditional QF scholarships, preschools are allowed to split 1 full time scholarship into two half-time scholarships. The data counts reflect 1 full time scholarship. Monthly reports from FTF will also show the number of children using the scholarships.
- FTF will provide monthly reports to the County showing the usage of scholarships per preschool. Reallocations of unused scholarships will occur periodically.
- County staff participate in monthly meetings with FTF and their scholarship vendor, Valley of the Sun United Way, to gain a better understanding of how the scholarships are managed, training provided to preschools regarding the scholarships, the fiscal monitoring and quality assurance checks undertaken, and to trouble shoot issues that may arise. For example, a list Frequently Asked Questions was developed for preschool providers about the differences between FTF funded traditional QF scholarships and the Pima County funded QF scholarships.
- The County issued its first of three equal payments (\$1,270,533.33) to First Things First.

New Free High Quality Preschool Classes Provided by School Districts and Funded by Pima County

The following is an update on these new classes offered by seven school districts:

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- The IGAs with Pima County provided funding for a total of 17 new preschool classes across seven school districts, with a maximum of 338 children depending on age. This part of the PEEP program is to specifically expand the capacity of the high quality preschool system (i.e. increase the number of high quality classes available), which is critical to having the necessary space to increase the number of 3-5 year olds from low income families that can attending high quality preschool.
- Several school districts participated in a technical assistance training for monthly invoicing and reporting in July. A second session will be offered in mid-August.
- School district preschool sites are required to be registered with Arizona Department of Economic Security (DES) to accept families with DES child care subsidies, and to be either in Quality First or have applied for Quality First. DES opened up a special process in July to onboard 12 school district sites that were not registered with DES. United Way of Tucson and Southern Arizona has offered to assist school districts that need to apply for Quality First as part of United Ways Accelerate Quality program.
- The IGA requires school districts to be operating these new classes by January 10, 2022. Most school districts intended to start the classes in August to match the regular school calendar. This flexibility was provided because of a number of uncertainties related to the pandemic. TUSD and Amphi have had difficulty hiring teachers to staff the classes. TUSD has pushed back their start date to September, still dependent on the hiring of teachers.

#### Expanded Head Start Programing Provided by Child-Parent Centers Funded by Pima County

The following is an update on the 11 extended day Head Start classes:

- All 11 classes will be open by August 16 if they aren't already. Some of the classrooms are still waiting on some final supplies to be delivered. In the meantime, the teaching staff conducts an orientation with children and families, and are arranging for home visits as well.
- Some of the classes still have lower enrollment numbers as CPC is still recruiting teachers in a few of the classrooms; the model is three teachers per class and some only have two so far.
- Across the 11 sites, enrollment is at about 50 percent. There is variation – some classes have as few as 5 children and others are as high as 15. The centers are still working through additional enrollment applications so more spots will be filled soon.
- CPC did run into an issue with the class at their Northwest location (2160 N. 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.) due to problems with staff qualifications and facility space. They requested and we administratively approved to move that set of "slots" to the second classroom at their Marana location. The map and data attached do not yet reflect this location move.
- The County issued its first of two equal payments (\$574,922.50) to Child-Parent Centers.

#### Expanding the Number of High Quality Preschools

The first guiding principle for this program refers to the need to increase the capacity of the high quality preschool system (i.e. increase the number of high quality preschool classes and providers). It is this current limited capacity which will limit the County and our partners in

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allocating all of the funding approved for this program in year 1. There simply are not enough preschool classes and providers currently rated or accredited as High Quality. While it is estimated we will serve about 20 percent of our target population this first year, that cannot increase significantly without expanding the capacity of the high quality preschool system.

Our strategy to increase capacity in this first year was to contract with school districts to add new high quality preschool classes. In addition to the new classes added by school districts, the capacity of the high quality system in Pima County is being expanded in a number of ways. First, DES and FTF have a new agreement whereby DES will use Federal funding to move approximately 800 child care and preschool providers state-wide that are currently on the wait list for Quality First into the Quality First program over the next three years. It is anticipated the first group of 100 providers on the wait list, statewide, will be notified this month of this opportunity. We will remain engaged in this process to understand which and how many providers are brought into Quality First, and rated at a 3-star and above, thereby increasing the capacity of the high quality preschool system.

Second, the United Way of Tucson and Southern Arizona has created a new program called "Accelerate Quality". Accelerate Quality is funded by donations from Tucson Medical System, El Rio, Southern Arizona Leadership Council, Community Foundation of Southern Arizona, other philanthropic donors, and individual donations that can be made using an online link. Through Accelerate Quality, preschools who are 2-stars can receive financial and other assistance to increase quality and prepare them to score at a 3-star (considered high quality); preschools not yet in Quality First can receive assistance in completing the application and preparing for the rating assessment; and those already in Quality First with a 3-star or greater rating who have space to add additional classes can receive financial or other assistance in getting those additional classes operational. Several preschools have contacted the County through [PEEPs@pima.gov](mailto:PEEPs@pima.gov) to inquire how they can participate in the PEEPs program. Staff are encouraging those that are not in the Quality First program to apply as that is the most likely way they will be able to receive scholarships in future years. Staff are also suggesting they contact United Way of Tucson and Southern Arizona for assistance with the application. United Way can provide assistance to preschools so that they are more likely to receive a 3-star rating during their initial QF assessment, and therefore be ready to receive scholarships.

Staff are also encouraging preschools to become registered with DES, if they are not already. DES will be allocating a portion of their Federal funding to increase provider reimbursement rates for children that have DES child care subsidies. It is estimated that for most situations, DES reimbursement rates for high quality preschools and child care will exceed FTF Quality First scholarship reimbursement rates for the first time. This should make the DES child care subsidies more attractive to preschool and child care providers, providing a greater number of high quality options for DES qualified families.

An obvious challenge to increasing the capacity of the high quality preschool system is having enough qualified teachers to staff such classes. This is a critical problem currently, as reflected by the updates so far from the school districts and Child-Parent Centers, and was an issue even before the pandemic. There are state-wide and local working groups that are developing recommendations on how to increase the number of qualified preschool

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teachers. Once we receive those recommendations, we can consider whether the County has a role in trying to address this challenge as it will be key to meeting our program goals.

#### Connecting Families with Schools and Financial Aid

Pima County is continuing to refer interested families to Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R). Each PEEP participating preschool has a CCR&R profile that has been updated to show they offer these scholarships. Families can either call the information line at 1-800-308-9000 and speak with a child care specialist who is trained to assist families with finding preschools that meet their needs, including those that offer financial assistance. Families can also search for preschools by zip code and other criteria by visiting CCR&R's website at [www.azccrr.com](http://www.azccrr.com). County staff and CCR&R staff meet regularly to address issues and continue to improve the experience for families.

#### City of Tucson and Towns of Marana and Oro Valley Funding

Pima County has received payment from the City of Tucson, Town of Marana and Town of Oro Valley for this program, totaling \$1,235,000. Staff will be reporting quarterly to each of these jurisdictions, and will provide a profile of sorts for each jurisdiction with the number and location of participating preschools, as well as the number of PEEP scholarships or new preschool class slots at preschools in each jurisdiction. These reports and profiles could be used to determine the appropriate future funding participation from each jurisdiction.

#### New Staff for PEEP

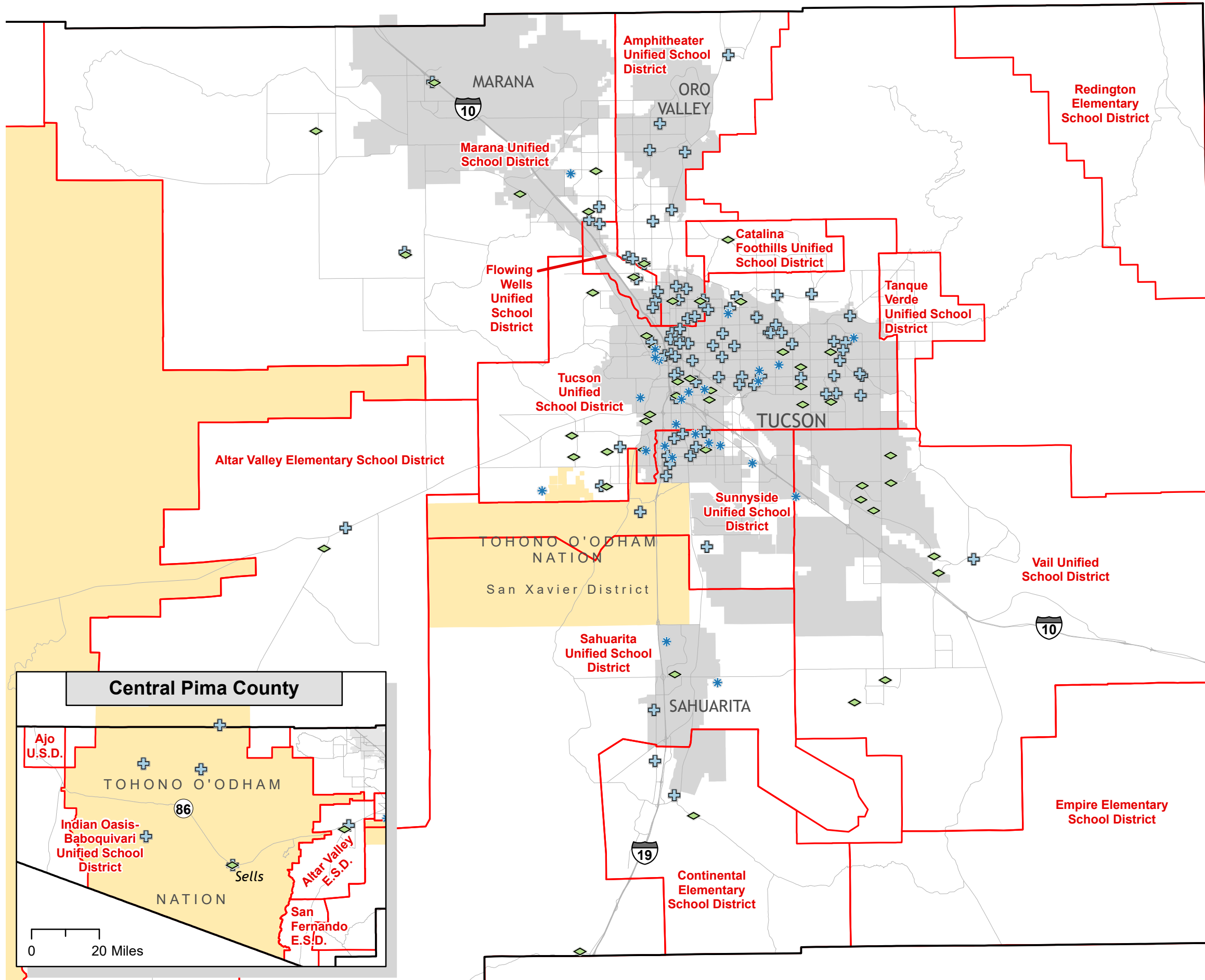

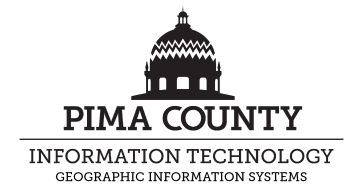

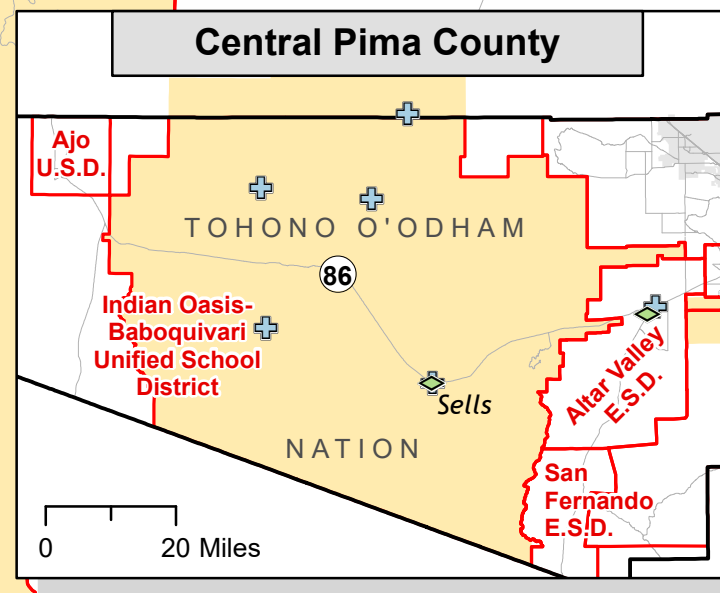
