Re: **COVID-19 Vaccination Report and First Mobile Vaccination Effort**

Pima County COVID-19 Vaccination Report – February 5, 2021

Attached is the latest vaccination report prepared by the Pima County Health Department. The report shows the total doses of vaccine administered to County residents as 131,322. As of February 8, 2021, the number of doses administered will be over 150,000.

The important information contained in this document relates to age distribution of those vaccinated versus the general population. For persons 60 years of age and older, 49 percent of that population has received a vaccination as compared to that portion of the regional population which is 26 percent.

Our Accelerated Vaccination Plan called for vaccinating the most vulnerable first, which simply means we began with the population of 75 years of age and older. We have now dropped that vaccination threshold to those 70 years of age and older. We anticipate opening vaccinations to those 65+ by the end of this month.

The data regarding those vaccinated shows that the strategy to vaccinate the most vulnerable is having an effect as there are over twice as many individuals age 60 and over who have been vaccinated as opposed to their representation of the population within Pima County.

Mobile Vaccination Pilot

Pima County held its first mobile vaccination clinic in cooperation with Tucson Medical Center on Saturday, February 6, 2021 at St. John's Evangelist Church near Valencia Road and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Over 500 individuals were vaccinated, who were predominately elderly, Hispanic and Spanish-speaking members of our community. As you will recall, our Accelerated Vaccination Plan called for multiple mobile clinics to reach isolated or vulnerable communities based on age and ethnicity. This first mobile clinic was viewed as a pilot program to fine tune future clinics and was deemed successful.

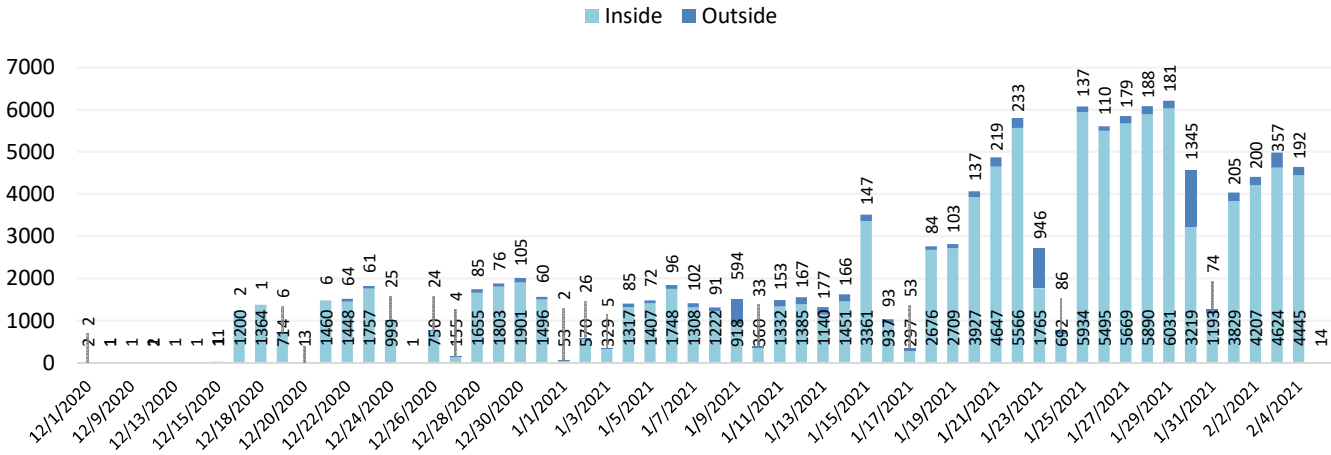
# Pima County COVID-19 Vaccination Report

February 5, 2021

**Total allocated doses administered to Pima County residents: 131,322**

As of February 5, 2021, a total of 115,995 (11.10%) Pima County residents have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. A total of 108,374 residents were vaccinated by a local provider in Pima County ("inside") and 7,581 residents were vaccinated by a provider outside of the county ("outside"). Note, dates that don't appear in graphs had zero vaccinations.

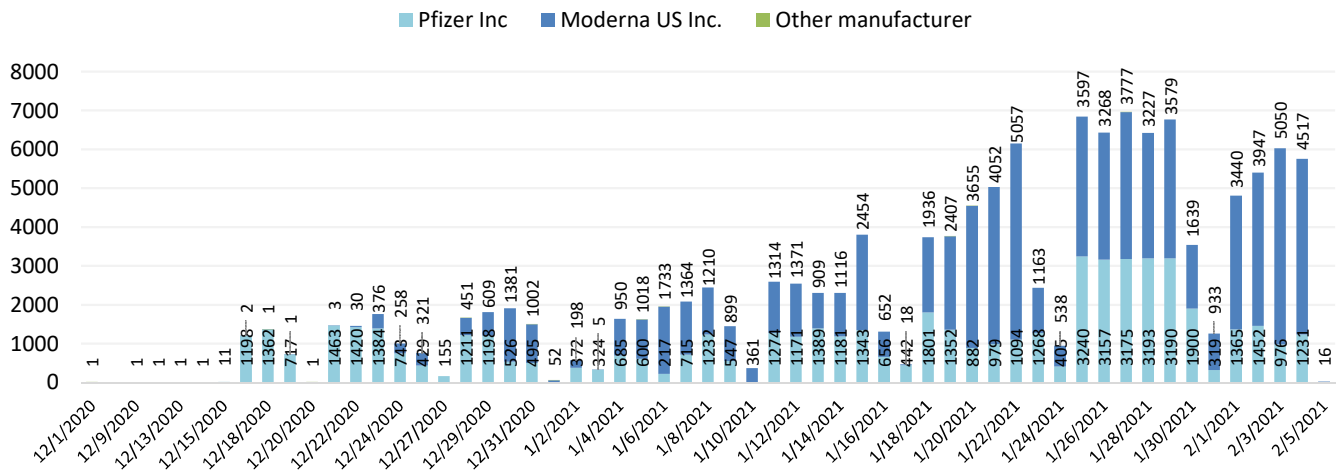
## Pima County First Dose Vaccinations by Date and by Location of Service
