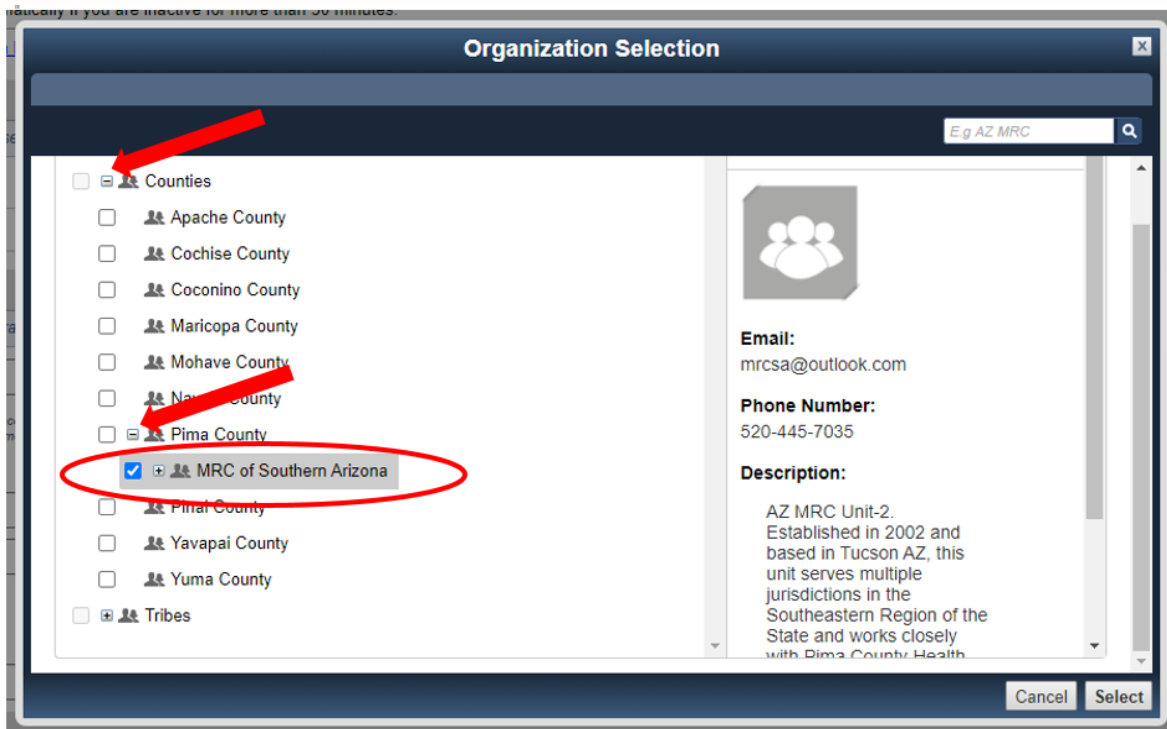

Re: **Medical Volunteers**

As mentioned in the recent Board Meeting, members of the Green Valley community who are trained or formally licensed healthcare workers would like to volunteer in assisting the County in our vaccination program. I indicated that if they are qualified and are interested in volunteering for such, they will need to register with the Medical Reserve Corps of Southern Arizona, which is a State requirement.

If there are a sufficient number of volunteers in the Green Valley area and the barrier relates to transportation, the County could provide van transport for those individuals who would want to volunteer at one of our regional vaccination centers. We will coordinate with the Green Valley Council if that need arises.
