Re: **March 5, 2021 Vaccination Report**

Attached is the latest Vaccination Report for your information. This information reflects the actual vaccines administered as of March 4, 2021. Please note the total vaccines administered to County residents stands at 297,058.

Today, we will surpass the 300,000 mark for vaccines, reaching a milestone in our Accelerated Vaccination Plan that would indicate we are approximately three weeks or more ahead of schedule. Just as important to the number of vaccines that have been administered is the age distribution. The data indicates that 60 percent of our vaccines have been given to individuals age 60 or older. This segment of the population is approximately 26 percent. Of those age 70 years or older, 43 percent of our vaccines have been administered to this age group, representing 14 percent of the population.

Of equal importance, the number of second dose vaccines, where an individual is fully vaccinated, now stands at 105,676.

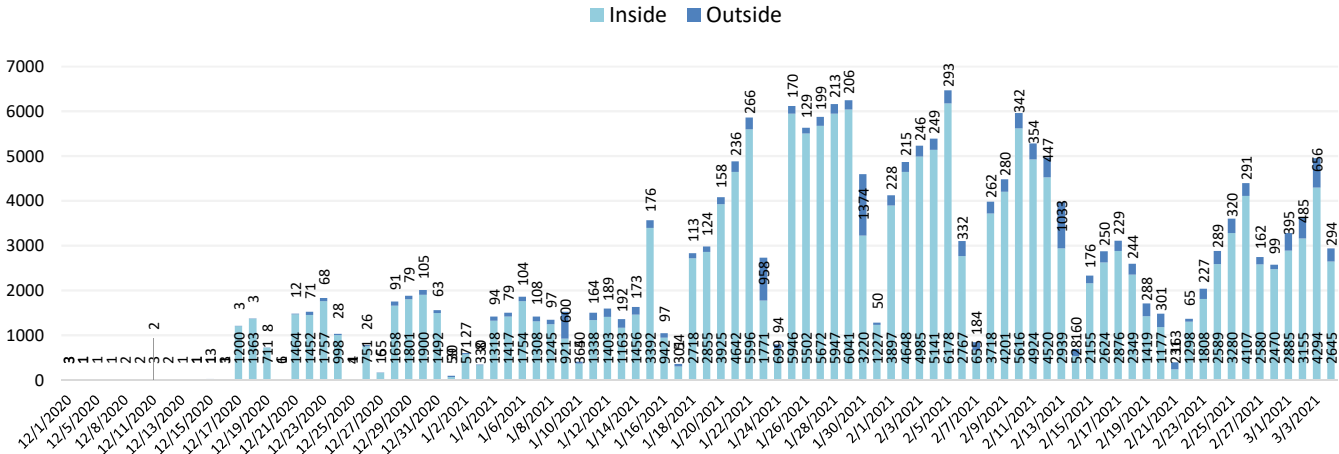
Pima County COVID-19 Vaccination Report

March 5, 2021

Total allocated doses administered to Pima County residents: 297,058

As of March 4, 2021, a total of 207,103 (20.0%) Pima County residents have received their first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. A total of 190,433 residents were vaccinated by a local provider in Pima County ("inside") and 16,670 residents were vaccinated by a provider outside of the county ("outside"). Note, dates that don't appear in graphs had zero vaccinations.

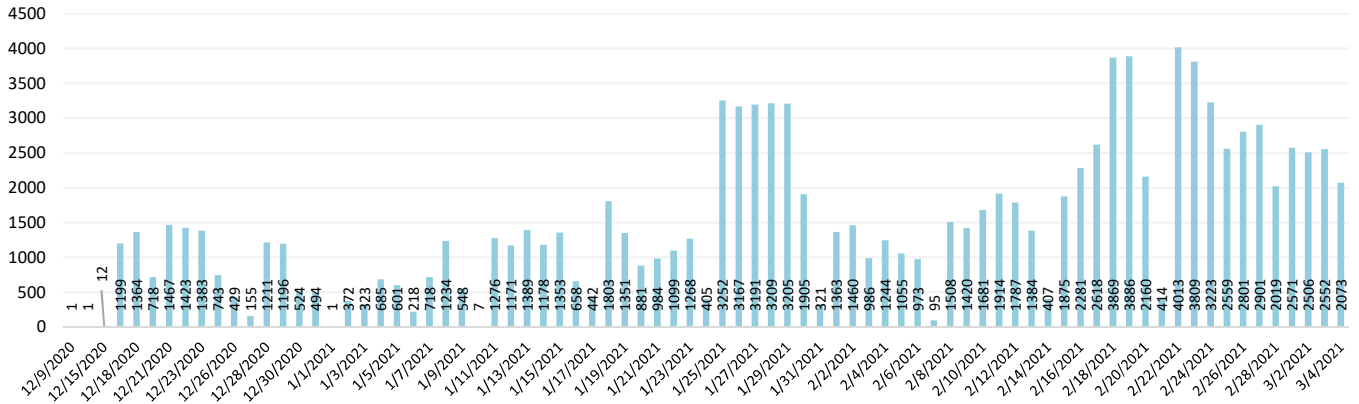
Pima County First Dose Vaccinations by Date and by Location of Service
