Re: **Weekly Vaccine Distribution from the State**

Given that vaccine supply is the determining factor for our vaccination application, it is appropriate to provide the Board with notice of our weekly allocations from the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) for vaccines. The allocations are normally made by the State and the County is notified on Thursday each week. This coming week when the vaccines arrive on Tuesday, we have been notified that we will have the following vaccine supplies:

- 23,000 Moderna
- 8,200 Johnson and Johnson
- 16,380 Pfizer (University of Arizona POD)
- 2,340 Pfizer – transfer from Tucson Medical Center to Kino/Banner South

As I have stated previously, the rate of vaccination at our regional centers has been restricted due to the lack of vaccine supply. The University of Arizona State POD is beginning to increase their vaccination rate and is being supplied exclusively with the Pfizer vaccine from the State of Arizona. They have an adequate supply to operate unrestricted; however, our other regional vaccination centers have been restricted in their vaccination output due to limited supply.

The actual vaccinations occurring at each of our vaccination centers since February 24, 2021 and the first four days of March are shown in the table below.
